About the Birds

- Scientific Name: Sialia Sialis
- Male: rich blue upperparts, red orange throat, breast, and flanks, white lower belly, white or red orange chin, narrow white border
- Female: gray brown back, white eye-ring on some, dull blue wings and tail, paler orange underparts
- Both: short, stout black bill, slightly notched at tip

Observations in the Field

1-6 eggs, 1-2 broods, 7-14 days for incubation, 7-14 days in nest, pale blue eggs

Nestlings are naked pink, with patches of gray fuzz, bright yellow beaks, eyes closed
