Throughout my dedication to the AYLUS Lake Washington Branch, I've spent the past two years leading the branch in serving the local community through a variety of initiatives, including the Accessible Learning, Habitat Restoration, and Event Support initiatives. The Accessible Learning Program is one of our branch's signature initiatives, contributing to our branch earning the new branch of the month award on ten separate occasions. Over the past two years, I've led a team of over 20 instructors and assistants who use their knowledge and skills to inspire and educate local children. I've led my branch to organize over 80 classes and camps, serving over 300 local families.
